

Resolution No. 3018

A Resolution of the City of Sanford, Florida, amending the City's annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021 and ending September 30, 2022; providing for implementing administrative actions; providing for a savings provision; providing for conflicts; providing for severability and providing for an effective date.

Whereas, the Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida has adopted an annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021 and terminating on September 30, 2022 specifying certain projected revenues and expenditures for the operations of Sanford municipal government; and

Whereas, the City's budget presumes that each department generally will, to the best of their ability, maintain its expenditures within its allocated budgeted level and exercise prudence in expending funds during the course of the City's fiscal year; and

Whereas, from time-to-time circumstances and events may require that the original City budget may need revision; and

Whereas, the City Commission, in its judgment and discretion, has the authority to adjust the budget to more closely coincide with actual and expected events.

Now, therefore, be it adopted and resolved by the City Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida as follows:

Section 1. Adoption of Budget Amendment.

The annual operating budget of the City of Sanford for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021 and terminating on September 30, 2022 is hereby revised and amended by Attachment "A". The Attachment is hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein verbatim. Except as amended herein, the annual operating budget for the City of Sanford for fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021 and

terminating on September 30, 2022 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 2. Implementing administrative actions.

The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to implement the provisions of this Resolution by means of such administrative actions as may be deemed necessary and appropriate.

Section 3. Savings.

The prior actions of the City of Sanford relating to the adoption of the City budget and related activities are hereby ratified and affirmed.

Section 4. Conflicts.

All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Severability.

If any section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution is determined to be invalid, unlawful or unconstitutional, said determination shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution not otherwise determined to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional.


Section 6. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon enactment.





STRATEGIC PRIORITIES:

SYNOPSIS:

Approval of Resolution No. 3018 to amend the budget in the amount of, \$20,376 to increase the Fire Department Capital funds is requested.

FISCAL/STAFFING STATEMENT:

Additional reserve funds are requested to fund the cost of the replacement roof for Station 38 in the amount of \$7,182.33 and dive gear replacement in the amount of \$3,005.45.

BACKGROUND:

The Fire Department was approved capital funds in the amount of \$40,000 for the replacement of the roof at Fire Station 38 in FY 21/22. The current estimated cost for a replacement roof is the amount of \$47,182.33. Due to current price increases, additional funding of \$7,182.33 is needed.

The Fire Department was approved capital funds in the amount of \$24,500 for the replacement of dive gear in FY 21/22. The current estimated cost for the replacement fire gear is the amount of \$27,505.45. Due to current price increases, additional funding of \$3,005.45 is needed.

LEGAL REVIEW:

No legal review requested of the City Attorney.

RECOMMENDATION:

City staff recommends that the City Commission approve Resolution No. 3018, to amend the budget in the amount of \$20,376 to increase the Fire Department Capital funds accounts.
